GOD NEWS

IN A WORLD OF BAD NEWS

Christianity is all about the good news of Christ—what Christians call the gospel. The gospel answers four big questions: Who is God? What is the human problem? What is God's solution to our problem? How can I be part of God's solution?

Who is God?

God created this world and all that is in it:
"In the beginning God created the
heavens and the earth...God created man
in his own image, in the image of God he
created him; male and female he created
them" (Genesis 1:1, 27).

He made us to be like him and to have fellowship with him forever.

What is the human problem?

Although God created us to have fellowship with him, we chose to rebel against him and reject his right as Creator to exercise authority over us—what the Bible calls sin.

Because of sin our fellowship with God was broken— "For the wages of sin is death (separation from God) (Romans 6:23)". We face God's righteous wrath instead of enjoying his holy pleasure.

What is God's solution?

However, because of his great love, God sent his Son, Jesus Christ to die in our place and to bear the penalty of our sin and to save us from sin and judgment.

The Bible says, "God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8).

God raised him from the dead, a demonstration of God's acceptance of Christ's sacrifice— "Christ died for our sins...he was buried...

He was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures...he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred..." (1 Corinthians 15:3-6).

How can you be part of God's solution?

One of the well-known verses in the Bible summarizes the required response to this good news: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).

To believe in Jesus is to trust him wholeheartedly for forgiveness and to turn away from your sins (to repent). If you believe in Jesus, you will be restored to a right relationship with God.

Do you believe that you have sinned against God and deserve his judgment? That Jesus Christ is the Son of God who took your place and died the death you deserved? That Jesus rose from the dead and lives as your Savior? If you believe that with all your heart, you can tell him in words like these:

Jesus, I can't save myself. I repent of my sins and trust you to forgive me and give me eternal life. Thank you for dying in my place to save me!

If you prayed this prayer and meant it, welcome to the family of God. It is important that you grow in this relationship and to do so we encourage you to join a Bible-believing church near you. We are happy to connect with you and help you along this journey.
